- *License by the Puerto Rico Board of Postsecondary Institutions since 1997 (Certification No. 2007-097 PRCHE).*

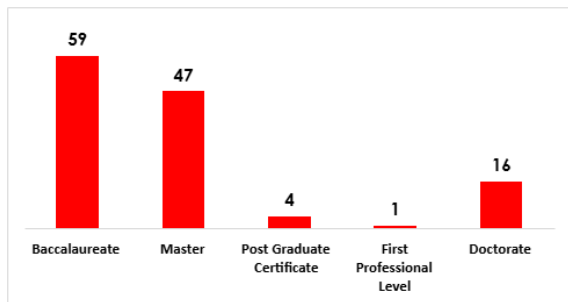
CARNEGIE CLASSIFICATION
